DESCRIPTION: ROOF REPLACEMENT

Bid submittals were received in response to the Invitation for Bid referenced above. Evaluation of these submittals has been completed by the South Central Illinois Mass Transit District (District), and will now be reviewed and potentially approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation. Contingent on IDOT approval, the District intends to award separate contracts to the apparent low bidders that were responsive and responsible.

McCord Admin - D7 Roofing LLC - #320,885.00

McCord Maintenance - Joiner Sheet Metal & Roofing - \$218,785.00

Locust Transportation Center - Joiner Sheet Metal & Roofing - \$50,076.00

This Recommendation for Contract Award Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the South Central Illinois Mass Transit District (The District) and the apparent successful vendor. The vendor shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the contract services until a contract containing terms and conditions acceptable to The District is executed. If the apparent successful vendor fails to negotiate and execute a contract with The District, The District may revoke the award and proceed at the direction of the Illinois Department of Transportation. The District further reserves the right to cancel this Recommendation for Contract Award Notice at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.

With respect to protests made after the deadline for submission of bids/proposals but before contract award by SCT, protests shall be limited to those protests alleging a violation of Federal or State law, a challenge to the bids/proposals evaluation and award process, SCT's failure to have or follow its protest procedures or its failure to review a complaint or protest. Such protests shall be submitted in writing (defined as being sent or received via letter or facsimile on official firm/agency letterhead or by electronic mail with sufficient documentation, evidence and legal authority to demonstrate that the Protestor is entitled to the relief requested) to the Procurement Officer as specified below not later than five (5) business days after the Recommendation for Contract Award announcement by SCT. The protest must be certified as being true and correct to the best knowledge and information of the Protestor, and be signed by the Protestor. The protest must also include a mailing address to which a response should be sent. Protests received after the deadlines for receipt of protests specified above are subject to denial without any requirement for review or action by SCT.

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
